

Address Change Notification to Canada Revenue Agency – Individuals

If you file your income tax return with an address change using an electronic filer, your address will be updated with the CRA on filing.

If your move occurs around the same time as filing your personal income taxes, then your address will be updated upon eFiling your income tax return. Otherwise, you should contact the CRA using one of the below methods so that you can continue to receive mail, payments, and other notices from the CRA without delay.

Ways to change your address with CRA:

1. Online
2. By phone
3. By mail or fax

Online

If you have registered with the My Account service with CRA, you can change your address by logging into your account or by using the MyCRA mobile app:

By mail or fax

Complete form [RC325](#) or write a letter including the following information and send to your [individual and benefits processing tax centre](#):

- Signature
- SIN
- New address
- Date of your move
